If your daughter would like to play an organised sport and represent Sacred Heart Girls' College, she will need to register her intention by completing these forms and returning them with full payment to the school office. Families need to be reminded this is **not** a school donation. These fees must be paid. Participation may be compromised should we have not received at least 50% of these fees or a payment plan in place at the beginning of the season. Students will also not be eligible to purchase additional 'school labelled' clothing if fees are not paid.

We appreciate that a student's situation or interest may change, resulting in a new enrolment or even reimbursement. If this happens, the situation can easily be accommodated by contacting the Sports Department.

On these forms please identify which sports, at this stage, the student is interested in participating in by ticking the appropriate box(s). Each sport also indicates in which term(s) the season runs which allow a decision to be made on whether commitment can be met.

Please tick the sport/s your daughter is playing this year and complete **ALL** the required information. <u>The attached</u> form must be returned with payment to the MAIN school office.

Rostered trials for all winter codes will be held during the weeks of **3 FEB – 6 MARCH**. It is your daughter's responsibility to check which sport for which year level are on which days.

Each member of a household must complete a separate form and pay separately.

<u>All</u> new students to this school are also required to pay a **\$40 uniform bond**. This is returned to you when your daughter leaves Sacred Heart Girls' College. However, if your daughter fails to return her uniform at the end of the season, or within the allocated time, the uniform bond will be taken to help cover the cost of a replacement, as well as an invoice to cover the full replacement costs. Another uniform bond will need to be paid the following year if your daughter chooses to play sport again.
