## **LOCKDOWN AKO@HOME 2021**

#### Year 7 & 8

- One scheduled 'live' online time per week with Homeroom teacher
- Homeroom teacher will set activities through TEAMS.
- Modules **paused** for now

#### Year 9-13

- Every class will have one scheduled 'live' online time per week during one of the originally timetabled slots, including Year 10 options. This can be used for a catch up, for a Q&A session, for explicit teaching, etc.
- Year 9 Modules will be paused for now
- Activities/tasks will be posted to TEAMS during the week

#### **Student Expectations and Responsibilities**

- Students will check announcements in TEAMS and school email at least once a day
- Students will attend any scheduled 'live' sessions
- Students will actively engage in learning tasks set on TEAMS and feedback from teachers where possible
- Students will communicate with their teachers if they are unable to do either of the above (attend 'live' sessions, or unable to complete the learning tasks)
- Students will contribute positively and respectfully online
- During 'live' sessions, students will wear appropriate casual clothing

## **Teacher Expectations and Responsibilities**

- Teachers will communicate directly with each class through TEAMS when their one 'live' session will be that week
- Teachers will use their other scheduled timetable slots however they find suitable- own time, creating resources, marking, feedback, further 'live' sessions, etc.
- Teachers will provide simplified learning tasks that are more appropriate to 'lockdown learning' than the original intended lesson plans
- Teacher will provide feedback to students within a reasonable timeframe (please remember some teachers have over 120-150 students to respond to!) through TEAMS or email
- Manaaki/GEMS teachers will meet once a week with their Manaaki class to catch up for some Hauora time
