



SPORT REGISTRATION FORM 2022

If your daughter would like to play an organised sport and represent Sacred Heart Girls' College, she will need to register her intention by completing the below forms and returning them with full payment to the school office ASAP.

Things have changed weekly with sport throughout this term as we have negotiated our way through Covid and Omicron. This form has been changed four times to accommodate these Government changes, so hopefully everything is more settled now. Please note vaccine passes are no longer required for your daughter to play school sport for Sacred Heart teams, although there may be specific venue requirements from time to time. In addition, as of April 5th, there will also be no vaccine pass requirement for coaches, managers, van drivers, or parent helpers to assist our sports teams.

Families need to be reminded that sports fees are **not** a school donation and must be paid. Participation may be compromised if we have not received at least 50% of these fees or a payment plan in place before the first game commences. Students will also not be eligible to purchase additional 'school labelled' clothing if sports fees are not paid.

We appreciate that even now, a few weeks before the season starts, a student's situation may change, resulting in a new enrolment or even reimbursement. If this happens, the situation can easily be accommodated by immediately contacting the Sports Department.

Students and parents/caregivers need to sign the Code of Conduct & Parent Permission sections respectively. On the back page, please identify which sports, your daughter is playing by ticking the appropriate box(es). Each sport also indicates in which term(s) the season runs which allows a decision to be made on whether full commitment can be met. Both pages must be returned with payment to the MAIN school office.

The greatest impact from Covid has been on our school-wide sports events, and the sports trials/musters, with many girls unable to attend due to home isolation. Please be assured that all girls who signed up have been allocated to a team. Due to fairness and transparency, most teams have been allocated via required positions before ability levels. In addition, 1-2 extra players have been added to squads this year, to ensure we will have enough players each week, when the next wave of Omicron comes rolling in! Please support the coach/manager when they play equal game time subbing with the players.

Each member of a household must complete a separate form and pay separately.

All new students to Sacred Heart Girls' College are also required to pay a **\$40 uniform bond**. This is returned to you when your daughter leaves the school. However, if your daughter fails to return her uniform at the end of the season, or within the allocated time, the uniform bond may be taken to help cover the cost of a replacement. Another uniform bond will need to be paid the following year if your daughter chooses to play sport again.
